Paper – I	General Studies – This paper marks will be counted for getting to write the Civil Services Mains exam.	200 Marks	Two Hours
Paper – II (CSAT) Syllabus	Aptitude Test (CSAT) – This paper is of qualifying nature, but candidate must score at least 33% marks in this paper. However, marks of this paper are not counted for writing the Mains examination.	200 Marks	Two Hours

Society	<p>Salient features of Indian Society, Diversity of India</p> <p>Role of women and women's organization, population and associated issues, poverty and developmental issues, urbanization, their problems and their remedies.</p> <p>Effects of globalization on Indian Society.</p> <p>Social empowerment, communalism, regionalism and secularism.</p>
